**STRATFORD ON FOOT:**  
Be sure to spend some time in the remarkable park system that surrounds the Festival Theatre and the Avon River. A path starts by the theatre and follows the river to the T.J. Dolan Natural Area (located off John Street). Here a well-marked trail meanders beside the river under a canopy of pine and maple trees. A delight for nature lovers.

**PARKING:**  
Downtown Stratford: There are nearly 800 metered spaces in the city centre; all meters are for two hours or more. All-day free parking is available at the Cooper lot on St. Patrick Street. There is a large lot on Erie Street between Ontario and St. Patrick streets, and on Cobourg Street west of Waterloo Street.

Free parking passes are available from the Visitors' Information Centre on York Street and at Tourism Stratford, 47 Downie Street. These are good for one day only of your visit at any meter in the downtown, excluding the York Street parking lot.

### OVERNIGHT PARKING ON STREETS IS PROHIBITED.

**Festival Theatre:** There is a large parking lot on Queen Street at the Avon River. Parking here is available during performances only. Price: \$6 for cars and \$7 for buses. Bus drivers are requested to drop off passengers in the designated area immediately to the east of the Festival Theatre or in the bus parking area in Upper Queen's Park. Bus engines must be shut off. Some free general parking spaces are available along the circular drive in Upper Queen's Park adjacent to the theatre. Free parking is available on both sides of the Avon River where not prohibited.

**Avon/Studio Theatre:** Use public parking in the downtown area as available. Bus parking is available along St. Patrick Street in assigned areas. Bus engines must be shut off. See parking for downtown Stratford above.

**Tom Patterson Theatre:** Free parking is available adjacent to the theatre and at the Stratford Arena.
